Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including open ended art, sensory opportunities, fine motor activities, and gross motor play. Children were not able to go outside this afternoon due to a heat warning in the area however, they spent extra time outdoors this morning before it was too hot.

The indoor learning environments are set-up with a variety of materials on low open shelving that allow children to explore freely. Loose parts and real-life items have been added to most of the environments. The Junior Preschool Room is lacking some of these materials, QA Monitor discussed adding loose parts and real-life materials with administrator during inspection. It was also recommended that art materials are open and accessible for children within the preschool rooms.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the indoor play area. A variety of documentation is displayed that supports the children's current interests (vehicles, building, big body movement, food, construction, beach and bugs) and learning experiences. Documentation includes connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.
