General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred on the three infant rooms and two preschool rooms associated with this license.</p> <p>Mandatory attendance sheets, daily information sheets, incident logs, and five new staff files were reviewed, and all were observed complete.</p> <p>In the Infant 1 room, Inspector observed documentation and pictures supporting the children's learning is displayed on the walls. Children playing with dolls, open-ended art of the children making animal tracks, lions and pigs and learning about animals are displayed.</p> <p>Infant 2 room, the children were observed coming in from outside play in the rain. Educators indicated that the children loved jumping in the puddles and splashing. Educators in this room were observed by the Inspector singing songs with the children using props for songs such as the "Itsy Bitsy Spider" and "Wheels on the Bus." Children were observed engaged in this activity with their educators singing and participating. Documentation and pictures on the walls also were observed of the children making smoothies, gross motor climbing and exploring pumpkins were displayed.</p>

General Comments

Infant 3/Toddler room, the children were observed having morning snack. Documentation depicts the children's learning, creating with chalk in the playground, building a snowman outside with the educators using watercolors and natural materials, paint with balls and learning about dinosaurs.

In the Jr PreK room children were observed during lunch eating macaroni, cheese and vegetables served by the childcare facility. Coffee filter snowmen, fall exploration of natural materials mural and pictures of the children painting outside were observed by the inspector displayed on the walls of the childcare room.

In the Preschool room, the children were observed creating snowmen, having morning snack and lunch. Children's open-ended art is displayed on the walls and examples of mark making were also observed. Children in this group were also observed going and coming back from walks during the inspection.

Inspector discussed with Administrator transitioning of infants to the 2-year-old room. This can only occur on the day that child(ren) turn two and not before as infants cannot be mixed with another age group, with the exception of before 8:30 and after 4:30 and can only be with preschool age children and cannot exceed the maximum group size for one educator.

Inspector observed the educators during the inspection down at the level of the children in their learning and play, actively engaged, and tending to their needs.
