Comments: Safety hazards such as rusty and sharp metal, broken glass, and rusty nails were found within the "meadow area," the "grove area," and on the pathway to the meadow. Old metal pieces, broken glass and debris is also collecting behind the garage near the grove area. Many hazards were picked up today at the request of the inspector, but the outdoor play area requires a thorough inspection and clean up by staff to remove debris that could pose safety risks. General Comments									
Completed renewal inspection today. The children were observed within their indoor and outdoor environment. Educators were observed to be engaged with the children at their level and additional staff were available to support the children while preparing to transition for outdoor play. Invitations were set out for the children to explore when they returned from outdoor play. Documentation throughout the room demonstrated the children's ongoing interests and experiences. Evidence of open ended art was observed within both rooms. Recommended adding some plexi glass display boards to the walls within the classroom environments to display the children's work, photos, stories. Staff were knowledgeable of life threatening allergies on site. Extreme allergy management plan is completed and up to date.
