Comments: Licensing staff noted that the rabbit cage, located in the indoor environment, had rabbit droppings on the floor located outside the cage, but still within the blocked off area for rabbit. Please ensure that the rabbit droppings are contained in the small rabbit cage in order to maintain the safety of the children.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Aug 26, 2022	
Comments: While licensing staff was inspecting the outdoor play area, it was noted that the tires have standing water inside the tire and could pose to be a safety hazard. Please ensure that standing water does not accumulate inside the tires in order to maintain the safety of the children.

Comments: Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a monitoring inspection visit when the afterschool school children were leaving the centre to go play at the school playground nearby. Licensing staff noted that not all children had their water bottle with them at the nearby playground. Please ensure that all children have water bottles when playing outside to ensure all children stay hydrated and cool.
