Licensing staff observed the children climbing and playing on the monkey bars, slides, swings as well as playing a game called, "Among Us." The children were also given a challenge of caring for their water balloon babies. Some of the water balloon babies popped and cooled off the children on this hot morning. The children were observed having lots of fun with this challenge.

The educators were seen engaged with the children during the entire inspection visit.
