General Comments
<p>Arrived to perform renewal inspection. Afterschool room was clean and well organized, materials were sufficient for the number of children present and were developmentally appropriate.</p> <p>Observed children given choice of activity upon arrival, children had snacks from their lunch boxes, coloured, read books and spent time with the rabbit in the classroom. The rabbit was gated off from the play materials and the area was clean and well maintained. Educators reminded children to wash their hands after handling the rabbit.</p> <p>Educators were also observed spraying and cleaning tables. Positive behaviour guidance was observed, and educators spoke to children in an appropriate tone at all times throughout the inspection.</p> <p>Purposely planned activities, long term projects and evidence of children's learning was not observed in the classroom during the inspection. Some colouring sheets that were completed by the children were posted on the walls however no other activities were visible. Educators should set an intention for each day and offer invitations to play, long term projects and other activities based on the children's interests to expand on their learning.</p> <p>Educators took the after schoolers on a hike on this date for their outdoor play time. Ratio and appropriate supervision were maintained at all times.</p> <p>The parent board should be well organized for parents to easily view past inspection and monitoring reports and</p>
