General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the facility for a monitoring inspection at 10:45am. Upon arriving, the children were observed engaging in outdoor activities. The children were playing in a large sprinkler, in the dramatic play house and near a sand hole. The educators were actively engaged in the children's activities and supervised them at all times. Accessories and play material such as water play squirters, pot and pans for the dramatic play house/ kitchen and balls were present. A large storage bin with other materials was also present. The children's personal belongings, such as hats, water bottles and book bags were properly stored outside. A first aid bag and daily attendance was also outside. A verbal prompt was given to the children to clean up and dry off before going inside for lunch. A head count was done to ensure that all children were present. Once inside, an educator prompted the children to use the washroom, change and wash their hands before entering the classroom. Free play occurred before the educators encouraged the children to gather their lunch boxes and sit down for lunch. The children washed their hands before eating. The educators were observed sitting at the tables with the children while they ate. After lunch, the educators were observed setting out arts and craft materials, a sensory bin, and, board games for the children to play with during "quiet time". The educators were observed circulation to each table and group of children to ensure proper supervision. The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The children's personal belongings were labelled and properly stored in their cubbies. The washrooms were clean and the children were supervised while they used the washroom. Various and sufficient indoor play materials were observed. Such as books, Legos, arts and crafts materials, a cozy corner with plush toys and sensory toys. Pictures of the children's families and artifacts were posted in the classroom. The necessary information was posted at the entrance and is clearly visible. Licensing staff recommends that the shaded area in the outdoor play area be moved to a more central area of the play area. Licensing staff recommends the addition of a sand box as the children are currently digging in a sanded area with limited digging accessories.
