Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor did a verification of the administrative documents on-site. During the verification, the Quality Assurance Monitor has observed that the Emergency evacuation and fire drills had been completed for November 2022 and December 2022 but was not completed in January 2023. Emergency evacuation and fire drills must be completed monthly, and evidence of the evacuation and fire drills must be documented and made available for review. An emergency evacuation and fire drill will need to be completed for the month of February and monthly afterwards.
