## **General Comments**

During the follow-up inspection, the inspector does not have access to the children's records and staff records as the office where these are kept is locked and the administrator is not on site. The operator must ensure that records and documents are accessible to authorized government representatives at all times. Operator must implement a plan to ensure that any record or document prescribed by regulation be accessible to licensing staff during the facility's operating hours. After 30 minutes, the administrator arrived at the facility to unlock the office and provided the inspector with requested documents. The administrator confirmed that she will make a new key for the staff member to stay compliant with the regulation.

Due to the fact that required documents could not be provided to the Inspector upon request, the facility was not compliant with the following Regulations:
