Comments:  During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that none of the educators hold an Early Childhood Education Certificate. Trained and qualified educators help to ensure quality services for the safety, security, learning, and development of children. This has been an ongoing non-compliance since the renewal inspection from 2022.
