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General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed during nap time, three children aged 15 to 23 months who were napping and a fourth child who was awake under the supervision of a single educator. The second educator was in the building taking her break. It is recommended to maintain a level of supervision that allows for a prompt response to the needs of the infants aged 15 to 23 months. At this young age, the children are very vulnerable. During naptime, situations such as a medical emergency, breathing difficulty, choking or any other incident may require immediate intervention. This recommendation is intended to reduce the risk and to maintain a safe environment for all the children. The children were observed playing in the outdoor and indoor play area. The children were also observed doing the transition for lunch time (lunch boxes) and to nap and quiet time. The educators were organizing a tie-dye shirt activity for this afternoon. The children who were not napping were engaged in helping the educators prepare the t-shirts. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
