Comments: During the follow up inspection, Inspector observed that children from the 4-year-old room were mixed with the children the school age room. These children were not recorded on the mandatory attendance records. Discussed with Educator in the room that the mandatory attendance records must accurately reflect the number of children in their care at any given time. When children join a group, they are to be added to that attendance records and signed out of the original room's attendance.			
33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Nov 28, 2025	
Comments: The outdoor preschool and school-age areas have a limited variety and quality of materials for the children to interact and engage with. The Operator is to ensure that the outdoor play area materials and equipment that are variety and in sufficient quantity for the number of children present. Examples of materials to add to the outside area are Tonka trucks, balls, art materials, outdoor games, skipping ropes, bubbles etc. * Some trucks were purchased but have since broken. Original comply by dates of November 10, 2025, and November 21, 2025.

Discussed with Administrator that the expectation is that the orders for compliance are completed by the date on the inspection. A follow up inspection to occur prior to license expiration.
