General Comments

Monitoring Inspection to follow up on orders for compliance ahead of Renewal Inspection. All orders are not compliant.

Children and educators were not on-site during Monitoring Inspection this morning, as they were on an outing to a local park. Educators have planned field games and brought a picnic snack. Outdoor play materials (a parachute, bubbles, balls, etc.) are accessible to children to explore freely while at the park.

Each learning environment is set-up with a variety of materials and invitations for the children to explore. The environments are organized and appear well-maintained.

A variety of documentation is displayed throughout the indoor and outdoor environments that supports the children's ongoing interests and learning.

The outdoor play area has a mud kitchen with a variety of real-life materials for the children to explore dumping, transferring, mixing and building. QA Monitor discussed with administrator on site the small climbing triangles, ensure that these are moved away from the building, fence and cribbing to ensure the fall zones are clear.
