Comments: 1 of the children's records did not have the medical practitioner indicated. Recommendation that Operator review all children's records to ensure that all required information is indicated.

Comments: 2 of the children's records do not have an emergency contact indicated. Recommendation that Operator review all children's records to ensure that all required information is indicated.

Comments: 1 of the children's files does not contain a copy of the immunization records or a copy of the exemption. Recommendation that Operator review all children's records to ensure that all required information is indicated.

Comments: During the inspection, inspector observed that there was a substitution to the morning snack. Operator must ensure that all substitutions to the menu are documented and that parents are made aware of these.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Aug 05, 2022	
Comments: The room in which toxic products are stored was unlocked when Inspector arrived on-site. Operator locked the door immediately. Inspector also found alcohol cans in the unlocked fridge. Operator must ensure that alcohol is inaccessible to children.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Aug 12, 2022	
Comments: Not all water bottles and food brought from home are labelled with the child's name. Operator must ensure that all food brought from home is labelled with the respective child's name.

Inspector observed positive interactions between the Operator and the children, such as getting on their level to play with them and speaking kindly to them.
