Comments: Inspector observes that there is a child safety lock on the door leading outside. Operator must consult their evacuation plan and remove the child lock from the exit in order to comply with the codes and standards under the Fire Prevention Act.

Comments: Lysol wipes were located on the counter during the time of the follow-up inspection. Operator placed these under lock and key while inspector was on-site. Deficiency is now compliant			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Aug 12, 2022	Sep 13, 2022
Comments: Inspector observed that each child's lunch box and food was labelled with their name. Inspector also observed that certain water bottles were not labelled with the child's name. A discussion was had with the Operator, who indicates that parents have been made aware of this requirement and that Operator has tape to label the water bottles. Deficiency is now compliant
