Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 2 bottles of Drixoral nasal spray and a bottle of adult vitamins in an area accessible to children. Medications must be locked and inaccessible to children. The operator immediately locked the medications. Deficiency is now compliant			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Sep 12, 2024	Sep 12, 2024
Comments: 2 out of 4 water bottles were not labeled with the name of the child. All personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The operator immediately added the name of the children to the bottles. Deficiency is now compliant			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Sep 12, 2024	Sep 12, 2024
Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed food in the fridge that was not labelled with the child's name. Food brought from home must be labelled with the child's name. The operator immediately labelled the food brought from home. Deficiency is now compliant

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.
During the visit, the following elements were verified:

- Ratio
- Outdoor play area
- Storage spaces
- If children's personal belongings are labeled and stored separately for each child.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children during circle time. The operator read a story to the children and asked open ended questions. Children were engaged in the story.
