General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

Children were observed both in the indoor and outdoor environment. The educators engaged with the children and were observed down at their level. The onsite Administrator was observed supporting all classrooms during transitions, modeling positive child guidance, and redirection by offering to fill a water table for a child that wanted to play in water after their hands were washed.

The indoor environments were set up in advance of the children returning from outside. The children were observed playing with cars, trucks, blocks, puzzles, and mark-making with markers, crayons, and chalk.

All rooms were observed going for a walk around the neighborhood. The outdoor play area had a wide range of toys and materials for the children to explore. The children are currently in the process of growing strawberries, cucumbers, parsley, mint, chives, lettuce, and tomatoes in their greenhouse. Documentation is displayed on the greenhouse highlighting what the children are learning and tracking the progress.

Cheese, crackers, craisins, and carrots were provided for lunch. Educators were observed sitting with the children, modeling positive eating habits.

Documentation both indoor and outdoor was current, meaningful, and reflects the children's ongoing learning and interests.

Hand washing, diaper changing, and naptime routines were observed.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, toddler daily sheets, nap sheets, and daily attendance sheets.	•
