Comments: QA Monitor reviewed Criminal Record Checks that were possibly expired. Two Criminal Records Checks of staff were observed to be expired. Staff are not to be left alone with children until updated records are obtained. QA Monitor discussed with Administrator on site. The Administrator began the process of submitting for new checks during inspection.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning/afternoon including outdoor play, stories, dramatic play, sensory opportunities, and music and movement. The infants were observed exploring a small slide, fine motor activities and reading with their educator. The two-year-olds in Room #3 were observed exploring glue and googly eyes under the direct supervision of their educator. The two-year-olds in Room #4 were exploring a magnetic tile invitation set-up in the Tuff Tray; they built and knocked down structures together. The preschool children in Room #5 were observed exploring the water table and reading stories with the staff.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident throughout the environments through invitations, documentation and materials added that support the children's current interests (babies, sliding, colours, dancing, water play, kitchen and animals). Documentation had been removed from the walls as the facility was preparing to be repainted over the weekend; QA Monitor was still able to observe documentation of the children's learning as the educators had the documentation available in each room.</p> <p>Diaper changing procedures were observed within the Infant Rooms and Room #3 - educators and children both washed their hands. The disinfecting spray was not left to sit for two minutes on the changing surface. Ensure diaper changing procedures are reviewed by staff. The QA Monitor also noted that the children's wipes are kept together in one bin, diapering materials are to be stored separately for each child.</p>
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General Comments

Grilled cheese sandwiches and pickles were served for lunch.
Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play and at arrival from school.
Monthly fire drills are documented.
Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
New staff file (4) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
Facility is currently exceeding the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (7 out of 10) requirement.
