<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning and afternoon. The infants went for a neighbourhood walk in the stroller and explored their outdoor play area. The Twos spent time outdoors and were observed during clean-up; educators supported the children in tidying up independently and sang a clean-up song. The preschool children in Rooms 4 and 5 were observed exploring the outdoor play area. They tested their limits by climbing and balancing on age-appropriate outdoor play equipment.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (vehicles, ocean and farm animals, water play, community helpers, opposites and sounds). Invitations to play were set up for the children throughout the day both indoors and outdoors. A walk log has been created to support educators in planning purposeful neighbourhood walks; educators document where they are going and the children's experiences and learning.</p> <p>QA Monitor noted that one educator is now taking on a Literacy Lead role within the facility. They are supporting educators and children by providing additional literacy opportunities and intentionally incorporating literacy throughout the learning environment. It was observed that this educator read a story with props and an activity to a small group of children in the outdoor play area.</p> <p>During the inspection, it was observed that the Administrator actively circulated throughout the building to provide support to educators and children as needed, including during transition periods.</p> <p>Nap time was observed today. The environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the</p>

environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap.

Tuna casserole was served for lunch today. Children were observed helping serve meals and tidying up their dishes independently when finished.

Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play, during washroom and diapering, routines and before mealtimes. Diaper changing procedures were observed to be followed in the Twos Room.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. Infant Daily Information sheets observed to be completed throughout the day.

New staff file (4) review was completed. Two files are missing signed statements, to be added.

Incident logs are complete and signed by parent/guardians.

Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (6/10) requirement.
