General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children observed during indoor play, transition times, outdoor play, snack and meal routines and nap time. Educators and children were engaged in outdoor play for most of the morning and afternoon, as it was warm and sunny.

Two pacifiers left out on the shelf and window ledge. Pacifiers must be kept in a labelled container.

Hand washing routines observed today.

A variety of types of documentation is posted throughout the learning environments supporting children's interests, learning and experiences. The children's portfolios are up to date with documentation. Ensure dates are included on documentation pieces.

Next steps - adding connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Next Steps - Twos Room:

Setting up environment before going outdoors, this will invite children to play when they arrive back to the indoor play area.

General Comments	
Adding labels and photos to storage bins. Adding photos of the children throughout the environment.	
Next Steps - Threes Room and Preschool Room (Full Day): Setting up easel for painting opportunities each day. Open ended art opportunities instead of preplanned crafts. Adding labels and photos to storage bins; this will encourage charterests centres to be more defined. (Example: Easel with Art Area).
