Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the June fire drill was not completed. Emergency and fire drills must be completed monthly. The Quality Assurance Monitor asks that two fire drills be completed for the month of August.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection. The following elements were verified: - Daily routine - Rest Area - Premises - Administrative records maintained on site - Indoor play area and materials - Transportation - Premises The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The operator confirmed that the Quality Improvement plan is current and confirmed that the 10 hours of professional learning for this renewal year is almost completed for eligible staff members. The Quality Assurance Monitor could not verify the method of transportation as it was not at this location. The method of transportation will be verified at a later date. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children eating their morning snack (lunch boxes). The weather did not permit outside play during the inspection. The children were observed playing in the indoor play area. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children engaged with an educator creating worms with Play-Doh. The children were also observed doing the transition to eat their lunch (lunch boxes) and then transition to have
