As discussed at time of inspection, when children are transitioning to a new group, they are to be signed out on the attendance record from the room they are leaving and signed in on the attendance record for the room they are joining. This ensures that everyone knows exactly who is in their group.

Comments: Emergency evacuation and fire drill not completed for July.

Comments: Chipped paint on wall outside girls bathroom to be painted. Bolt covers on base of toilets missing. To be replaced. Walls and door frames of both girls and boys bathrooms unclean and require cleaning.

Comments: Clutter and debris observed on yellow cabinet near back exit. Tops of shelving and cupboards cluttered with materials. Clutter to be removed and/or organized to create a cleaner, inviting environment. Baseboards in classroom unclean and dusty. Require cleaning.

Comments: Large rainbow climbing mat in disrepair. Foam covering is peeling and cannot be adequately cleaned. To be removed and/or replaced.

Comments: One incident log dated August 2, 2023 not signed by parent. Incident logs are to be signed by parents/guardian to demonstrate they have been informed.

A renewal inspection was completed today. Children were observed in the indoor play environment.

The indoor play environment is set up with interest centres and an abundance of materials that provide choice for the children in what they want to play with. Children and educators were engaged in a variety of activities and play throughout the indoor play environment. Building tents, playing games, with lego, and creative art. Educators sat with children and engaged in conversation.

Documentary evidence in the form of planning, photos, and art work were present.
