General Comments

I arrived at the facility and the younger children were preparing to go outside. Upon return indoors the school-age children joined the environment. The educators were engaged with the children in play and conversation. The environment is set up with many learning centres for choice of play. This includes but not exclusive to reading, blocks, art, dolls, kitchen, and cars.

The educators are using calendars to pre-plan for the children's learning. They are using a portfolio to keep some of the work for the children along with learning stories that they have written over the year. One of the educators stated that they also document the interests of the children by webbing. I suggested that they also take pictures of that process and keep it on file.

The children will take part in their graduation tomorrow. The educators chose a theme of the Very Hungry Caterpillar. The giant caterpillar with the future aspirations of the children posted on the body and the centre pieces were very creative ideas to help enhance this occasion for the children.

A pre-planned program and evidence of the children's learning is evident. Educators are using a journal to write down planned ideas, a calendar for school age children. a portfolio for each child, pictures of the children and learning stories were seen.

The files are well organized, and the information was easily verified for licensing purposes. The educator was well informed of what information was required in the files and was able to help guide licensing staff through her inspection.

Positive child guidance was observed at time with visit. Redirection, calm voices, and gentle reminder were used with the children.
