Comments: While reviewing staff members' files, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that one staff members' Criminal Record Checks/Vulnerable Sector Checks had expired. The operator must ensure that all staff members maintain a valid Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check in accordance with licensing requirements. These checks must be renewed at least every five years and kept on file.

Comments: The QAM observed that a cabinet located under the bathroom sink, containing cleaning supplies, was not locked and was accessible to children. The concern was addressed immediately during the inspection. The cleaning product in the cabinet was removed and relocated to a locked storage area, ensuring it was no longer accessible to children. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The QAM was on site to conduct a monitoring inspection. During the visit, the following elements were reviewed and verified: - Staff records and checks - Indoor play areas - Indoor play materials and equipment - Washrooms - Personal belongings storage - Storage spaces During the inspection, children were observed participating in indoor play. The QAM spoke with the educator about the daily routine, including outdoor play. The educator explained that children go to the park twice a day

and typically spend one hour or more outdoor. Outdoor play was not observed during the inspection, as the group's scheduled park time was at 4:00 p.m. The educator indicated that the children would remain at the park until they were picked up by their parents.

The QAM noted that one staff member's Social Development check appeared to be expired in the file available for review. A valid Social Development check was on file at another facility. During the inspection, the administrator retrieved the documentation, and the valid Social Development check was provided for verification. The Operator must ensure that complete staff files are maintained and available at each facility where staff members are employed.
