<p>Comments: While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor observed in a cabinet not locked by key toxic products such as All-purpose cleaner Lysol, Bleach, Heat'n Kleen the easy kettle cleaner and Vim cream . The educators immediately moved the toxic product in a locked storage space. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all toxic products must be in a locked storage space. The operator explained that the cabinet where the toxic product was found belongs to the church that they share a space with, and they can't put a lock on the cabinet. The Quality Assurance Monitor suggested that the educators could easily put a lock on the cabinet before the children arrive on site and remove the lock once all children have left the facility. Deficiency is now compliant</p>
