General Comments

- -Visit to learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour, when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs.
- -Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height
- -There is a space of at least 46 cm between rest equipment and all nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent
- -Each cot is stored so there is no contact with another napping equipment
- -Each child under 15 months has a designated crib or playpen that meets the cribs, Cradles and Bassinets Regulations and the Playpen's Regulations under the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children
- -Indoor environment provides for children a space that is safe and clean. The material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present, easily accessible on low, open shelves.
- -It was seen during that there is, purposely planned and documented programing.

Observations: When arriving at the center one child was just waking up from her nap, the others were still sleeping. Discussed with the operator the functioning of her center, she shared with me her routine of the day and different strategies she has put in place so she could go get her daughter at the bus stop. Activities done with the children were exposed in the main room.
