Comments: Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility during nap time. A group of children were engaging in quiet time centres where children were assigned to specific centre. Licensing staff observed children not allowed to go to other centres once assigned to a specific centre. This does not align with the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework for Early Learning and Care- English. Also, according to Regulation 21 (a) The daily activities of a licensed facility shall be purposely planned in advance and documented and shall respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child and shall include: (a) time and space for a free choice of play experiences for exploration and discovery. Please ensure that the children have time and space for free choice of play experiences for exploration and discovery even during quiet time activities. 49(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that the guidance of the children receiving services at the licensed facility is positive and includes positive reinforcement, encouraging efforts and recognizing accomplishments. Comments: Licensing staff observed an educator using an inappropriate tone with the children; however, positive child guidance was observed by all other educators during the inspection visit.
