General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a follow-up monitoring inspection visit on October 6th, 2022.

Upon arriving at the centre all of the children were headed outdoors to play except for the two year old group who were about to have their afternoon snack.

Child-to-staff ratio was calculated and all classrooms were within regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act.

The infants were engaging in free play activities, the three/four year old children were participating in a colour scavenger hunt, and the school-aged children were engaging in dramatic play which included the educator.

While conducting the monitoring inspection, a number of educators relayed to licensing staff that during quiet time centres, the children are now able move freely from one quiet time centre to another. Licensing staff also noted that all educators, present at the licensed facility on the day of the follow-up monitoring inspection visit, were using an appropriate tone while speaking with the children.
