While observing children in the outdoor play environment, licensing staff noted a turf mat located just inside the gate in the infant outdoor play environment that, when lifted, has exposed screws that poses to be a safety hazard. When this was brought to the attention of the educators, the educators removed the mat from the environment to ensure the safety of the children.

Comments: While conducting observations in each classroom, licensing staff noted the infant room does not have any mark-making materials for the infant to access. Please ensure mark-making materials are accessible to the infants at all times while playing in the indoor play environment.						

## **General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the yearly License Renewal Inspection.

The three- and four-year-old children were engaging in play activities when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility. The four-year-old children were finishing up their circle time and then quickly transitioned into a craft activity consisting of beads, different coloured construction paper cut into narrow strips to create a bracelet using stickers. The children also had pipe cleaners and beads to make a different type of bracelet if they chose to.

The three-year-old children were engaging in a tower building activity using white plastic cups and also had small wooden spindles to explore and play with.

Once the children finished their craft and tower building, they transitioned to outdoor play where the children were observed acting like dinosaurs, as well as dramatic play, pretending to be at the beach.

The infants were engaging in free play activities outdoors before going inside for lunch and then nap time.
