Comments: All educators must start to record a purposely planned program that is responsive to the children's interests, passions and strengths.

Comments: One staff file does not have a copy of their signed statement. All staff files must contain a signed statement of understanding regarding their obligations under the Act and Licensing Regulation. Was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Three staff files do not contain a copy of first aid and CPR as the staff have not completed the training. They must complete the training and a copy of their certificate must be placed in their files.

Comments: A coffee cup was present on a shelf in the infant room. No hot beverages are permitted. Was corrected during the inspection when the Administrator removed the cup from the room. Operator must ensure that all staff are aware of this safety hazard and do not bring hot beverages into areas where the children are present. Deficiency is now compliant.
