## **General Comments**

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed snack time, the rest period, lunch and outdoor and indoor free play.

The inspector observed in 1 classroom an empty milk bottle on a nap mat. The inspector had a discussion with the educator, who confirmed that the child did consume the milk while laying down. Discussion was had with the educator that this practice is not permitted as it poses a risk of choking.

A discussion was had with administrator regarding infant's rest period. Inspector provided Administrator with their recommendation regarding this.

Recommendation that a larger 2nd surface be added in the infant's outdoor play area.
