Comments: An educator's file is missing a copy of their proof of registration for the Introduction to ECE course. Once the proof of registration is obtained, a copy of this must be placed in the staff's file.			
11.1(3) A staff member who works directly with infants or preschool children shall complete in each year 10 hours of training approved by the Minister related to the curriculum used at the designated facility.	11.1(3)	Nov 24, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, Inspector was unable to obtain proof that all eligible educators have completed their professional learning hours. Administrator indicates that they have asked the educators for this information and will follow-up with them. This will be verified at the 2nd follow-up inspection.			
22 The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include (b) a period of rest for a length of time that meets the needs of each infant and preschool child receiving services at the licensed facility but that does not exceed two consecutive hours unless there is a written request from a child's parent or guardian to extend the length of time.	22(b)	Nov 10, 2023	Dec 06, 2023
Comments: A discussion was had between the Inspector and the Administrator regarding the rest period. Administrator shared what plan has been put in place in order to ensure that the rest period meets each child's individual needs. Administrator indicates that they are actively monitoring this to ensure that the children's needs are met. Deficiency is now compliant			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Dec 11, 2023

<p>Comments: 1 out of 5 verified children's records has an emergency contact that lives more than an hour away from the facility. Administrator must ensure that all emergency contacts reside less than an hour away from the facility, in order to be able to pick up the child in case of an emergency within an hour.</p>

<p>Comments: Required proof has been provided to the inspector. Deficiency is now compliant</p>

<p>Comments: 1 out of 5 verified children's records is missing the consent to administer acetaminophen. Administrator must ensure that all required information is indicated in each child's record.</p>			
<p>32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility,</p>	32(1)(b)	Nov 20, 2023	Dec 06, 2023
<p>Comments: Art material is placed on low shelves in order for the infants to have access to this material. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	33(1)	Nov 24, 2023	
<p>Comments: Inspector observed a bin with a few kitchen items as well as a few trucks for the children to play with in the outdoor play area. Administrator must ensure that more materials are accessible in the outdoor play area. As per the Operator Manual (page 75), the outdoor play area is an extension of the indoor play environment, providing many of the same opportunities, including space for creative, quiet, pretend and sensory experiences. Recommendation that Administrator consult the Operator Manual (page 169), for suggested materials and equipment for the outdoor play area.</p>			
<p>41(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall (a) post diaper-changing procedures in diaper-changing areas.</p>	41(3)(a)	Nov 10, 2023	Dec 06, 2023

<p>Comments: Required information was indicated on the Management of potential illness forms. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.</p>	48(2)	Nov 24, 2023	Dec 06, 2023
<p>Comments: All verified lunch boxes and water bottles are labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (d) ensure that each bottle is stored with a cover in the refrigerator.</p>	48(4)(d)	Nov 10, 2023	Dec 06, 2023
<p>Comments: Infant bottles are placed in the refrigerator with a cover. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>48(5) If more than one bottle-fed infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall ensure that each bottle is (a) labelled with the child's name, (b) used only for the intended child.</p>	48(5)	Nov 10, 2023	
<p>Comments: There is an infant's bottle that is not labelled with the child's name. Educator informs inspector that they are not sure who the bottle belongs to. Administrator must ensure that they identify who the bottle belongs to and ensure that a label with the child's name is placed on the bottle.</p>			
<p>48(6) An operator of a licensed facility shall post information relating to any allergies of the children in the food preparation area.</p>	48(6)	Nov 17, 2023	Dec 06, 2023

Comments: Inspector observed that an incident log was filled out on December 1st 2023. All required information was indicated, apart from the parent's signature. A discussion was had between the Inspector and the educator regarding this. Educator indicates that they will obtain the parent's signature today.			
50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child involved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.	50(2)	Dec 06, 2023	
Comments: Inspector observed that an incident log was filled out on December 1st 2023. All required information was indicated, apart from the parent's signature. A discussion was had between the Inspector and the educator regarding this. Educator indicates that the parent was made aware of the situation verbally. Educator indicates that they will obtain the parent's signature today.			

**General Comments**

Regulation 41(3)(a): Inspector observed that the diaper changing procedures are posted in all required washrooms. Inspector observed that one lid was not tightly covering a garbage can. This was addressed with an educator, who placed the lid on the garbage can immediately. Deficiency is compliant.
