Comments: During the follow-up inspection, Inspector observed some play material in the outdoor play are, such as trucks, a few bowls, a few kitchen items and few scooters. Inspector observed that some outdoor play material, such as balls, were on the other side of the fence where children do not have access. Inspector observed that a few children did not appear to be engaged in outdoor play. A discussion was had with Administrator regarding the outdoor play material. Administrator indicates that they will be making a list of the outdoor play material that will be purchased based on the children's interests. Administrator also indicates that they will be looking at finding solutions to prevent the outdoor play material from going on the other side of the fence. Administrator also shares that a discussion was had with staff regarding engaging in play with the children while outside. The outdoor play material will be verified during the 4th follow-up inspection.
