If the certification is not an equivalent, the administrator has confirmed that the staff will enroll in the course as soon as possible. If the certification is an equivalent, a document stating the equivalence should be placed in the staff records. A note indicating equivalence or a proof of new certification can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor upon completion. A copy must be placed in the staff records.</p>

<p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the outdoor play area during this inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed 3 large spaces used by school age children. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the outdoor play area did not have a variety and sufficient quantity of material. The outdoor play area is an extension of the indoor play areas and must offer a variety of experiences and opportunities.</p>
