Comments: 1 out of 10 verified children's records is missing the full address of their medical practitioner. Recommendation that administrator review all children's records to ensure that all required information is indicated in each child's record.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Dec 04, 2023	
Comments: 2 out of 10 verified children's records are missing the full address of the child's emergency contacts. Recommendation that administrator review all children's records to ensure that all required information is indicated in each child's record.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (f) daily attendance records of the children on forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(f)	Nov 20, 2023	Nov 20, 2023
Comments: 1 child's arrival time was not indicated on the daily attendance record. Inspector addressed this with the educator, who added the child's arrival time on the daily attendance record immediately. Deficiency is now compliant			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (l) management of potential illness forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(l)	Nov 20, 2023	
Comments: Management of potential illness forms are filled out when required. However, Inspector observed that the license number was not indicated on 3 separate management of potential illness forms and 2 forms did not indicate the child's departure time. Administrator must ensure that all required information is indicated on these forms.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Nov 27, 2023

<p>Comments: Inspector observed that there is insulation coming out of one of the classroom doors. Administrator must ensure that the insulation is covered and is not accessible to children. Inspector also observed dust on top of a white shelf in the classroom as well as on the windowsills. Administrator must ensure that the indoor play area is maintained cleaned.</p>			
<p>33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.</p>	33(2)	Nov 27, 2023	
<p>Comments: There is missing protective surfacing underneath the swings and the slide. Administrator must ensure that required protective surfacing is added as per the manufacturer's manual. Recommendation that children do not use this equipment until required protective surfacing is added.</p>			
<p>40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.</p>	40(1)(a)	Dec 04, 2023	
<p>Comments: Inspector observed that not all children's cubbies and hooks are labelled with the child's name. Inspector also observed that 4 out of 5 verified children's water bottles are not labelled with the children's name. Administrator must ensure that children's personal belongings are labelled.</p>			
<p>48(6) An operator of a licensed facility shall post information relating to any allergies of the children in the food preparation area.</p>	48(6)	Nov 23, 2023	
<p>Comments: Inspector observed that children's allergies are not posted near the microwave in the classroom, which is used to prepare the children's food. Administrator must ensure that allergies are posted near the food preparation area.</p>			
<p>50(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall maintain a chronologically filed daily incident log relating to the health, security and well-being of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	50(1)	Nov 20, 2023	
<p>Comments: 5 verified incident logs do not indicate the care that was provided to the child following an incident. Administrator must ensure that incident logs contain the following information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child's name - Date - Time - Injury occurred and care that was provided - What happened and ; - Parent's signature 			
<p>50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child involved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.</p>	50(2)	Nov 20, 2023	
<p>Comments: 6 verified incident logs were not signed by the parent. Administrator must ensure that parent's sign all incident logs to confirm their awareness of an incident that has occurred.</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, inspector observed the children arriving from school, indoor play, outdoor play as well as snack time. Inspector observed children engaged in an activity organized by the educator (making crafts out of clay), while other children chose free play. Inspector observed the educators respecting the children's needs by offering the children more food upon the request.</p> <p>Inspector observed that the substitution to the menu made on November 20th 2023 is documented "nachos, salsa and popcorners" on the menu in the classroom. However, the substitution to the menu located in the kitchen is indicated as "odds and ends". Inspector recommends that this documentation be more precise.</p> <p>Administrator must ensure that a new copy of the facility's general liability insurance is provided to the inspector before the renewal of the license.</p> <p>Ratio is respected during the inspection.</p>
