Comments: All required information for the emergency contacts was indicated in each verified children's record. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector was unable to verify management of potential illness forms on this license. However, inspector was able to observe that required information is indicated on management of potential illness forms on other licenses. Inspector observed that administrator is vigilant about ensuring that correct information is indicated on these forms. Deficiency is now compliant			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Nov 27, 2023	
Comments: Inspector observes that there is still insulation coming out of one of the classroom doors. Administrator must ensure that this is covered and not accessible to the children. Inspector observed no dust in the indoor play area.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Nov 27, 2023	
Comments: Due to the snow, Inspector is unable to observe the protective surfacing around the stationary equipment. Inspector does not recommend that the stationary equipment be used until the snow is gone and required protective surfacing is present. Quality Assurance Monitor will verify protective surfacing at a later date.

Comments: Inspector observed that the children's clothing items are not stored separately in their respective cubbies. Administrator must ensure that children's personal belonging are stored separately.			
48(6) An operator of a licensed facility shall post information relating to any allergies of the children in the food preparation area.	48(6)	Nov 23, 2023	Dec 06, 2023
Comments: Allergy information is posted in the food perpetration area. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Required information is indicated on the incident logs. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Required information is indicated on the incident logs. Deficiency is now compliant
