Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the staff member missing a copy of a valid first aid certification had completed their course and a certificate was placed in the staff file. Deficiency is now compliant			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	May 24, 2024	
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor was on-site to verify if the hole in the wall had been repaired. The hole had not been repaired since the last inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator. The operator confirmed this would be done the next day.			
31(4) An operator shall ensure that the outdoor play area of a licensed facility (a) includes a shaded area that is at least 10% of the outdoor play area.	31(4)(a)	May 24, 2024	
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor was on-site to verify this element. New posts have been installed in the outdoor play area but the tarps have not yet been installed to provide the shade required as per 31(4)(a).			
51(3) The operator of a licensed facility shall (c) forward the original to the Minister within 24 hours of the incident.	51(3)(c)	Jul 25, 2024	Jul 25, 2024
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor followed up on an incident that required the facility to be temporarily closed as no incident report had been sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor to advise the minister of the temporary closure. The administrator shared that they had a water line break. The administrator completed the incident report and sent it to the Quality Assurance Monitor during the time of the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(5) The number of children grouped at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre shall not be more than the number that requires two educators.	9(5)	Jul 25, 2024	Jul 25, 2024

Comments:	During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the ratio in a school age group. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked an educator in the group how many children they had. They responded they had 31 children present in their group. A group of children cannot be greater than what is required for two educators. A school age group cannot be greater than 30 children as the ratio is 1 educator for 15 children. The administrator explained that they had combined 2 groups as one class was closed for the day. The administrator showed that there were two attendance clipboards, one for 15 children and one for 16 children. The ratio was respected as there were sufficient staff for the number of children however the educators were counting the children as one whole group instead of two separate groups within the same room. The administrator had a discussion with the educators to explain how the groups are divided so each understand which children they are responsible for. Deficiency is now compliant
