| Comments: 50% of educators do not hold a one year Early Childhood Education Certificate or an equivalent. Administrator indicates that they are the process of hiring qualified educators in order to meet this requirement. | | | |

| Comments: 1 out of 6 verified children's records is missing the full address of the medical practitioner. Administrator must ensure that all required information be indicated in all children's records. | | | |
| 24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached, | 24(1)(b)(iv) | Jan 31, 2024 | |
| Comments: 1 out of 6 verified children's records is missing the full address of the emergency contacts. Administrator must ensure that all required information be indicated in all children's records. | | | |
| 24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (v) the child's health history and a copy of the record of immunizations or a copy of an exemption. | 24(1)(b)(v) | Jan 31, 2024 | |
| Comments: 1 out of 6 verified children's records is missing a copy of the immunization record or the exemption form. Administrator must ensure that all required information be indicated in all children's records. | | | |

| Comments: 1 educator's file is missing a copy of their Introduction to Early Learning and Childcare certificate. This was added to the file during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant | | | |
| 31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children. | 31(3) | Jan 17, 2024 | |
| Comments: There is ice underneath the stationary equipment in the outdoor play area. In order to ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazard, this must be removed. | | | |
| 39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications. | 39(2)(b) | Jan 17, 2024 | |
| Comments: Inspector found a bottle of medication on a high shelf in a classroom. Educator indicates that it was placed in their backpack which is out of children's reach. A reminder was made to the educator that all medication must be locked. Administrator must ensure that all medication be placed under lock and key. | | | |
| 40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child. | 40(1)(a) | Jan 24, 2024 | |
| Comments: 3 verified water bottles are not labelled with the child's name. Administrator must ensure that children's personal belongings be labelled with their names. | | | |
| 41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (a) equipped with rails or safety straps. | 41(1)(a) | Jan 24, 2024 | |
| Comments: The diaper changing area is equipment with a safety strap, however the safety strap is broken. Administrator must ensure that this be repaired. | | | |
| 44 An operator of a licensed facility shall have a first aid kit that is equipped with the contents prescribed by New Brunswick Regulation 2004-130 under the Occupational Health and Safety Act as a first aid kit that is not a personal, Type P first aid kit, and a telephone in working order (a) on the premises of the licensed facility. | 44(a) | Jan 24, 2024 | |
| Comments: Inspector observed that there is missing hydrogen peroxide in a classroom's first aid kit. Administrator must ensure that the first aid kit contains all required materials. | | | |
| 45(3) If a child has or may be affected by a disease that is required to be reported under the Public Health Act and the regulations under that Act by the operator of a licensed facility, the operator shall (a) complete the forms provided by the Minister. | 45(3)(a) | Jan 17, 2024 | |
| Comments: Management of potential illness forms are filled out as required. However, the departure time was not indicated on two of the verified forms. Administrator must ensure that these forms indicate all required information. | | | |
| 48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required. | 48(2) | Jan 24, 2024 | |
| Comments: 3 verified children's lunch boxes are not labelled with the child's name. Administrator must ensure that all food brought from home is labelled with the child's name. | | | |

General Comments

Regulation 33(2) could not be verified at time of inspection due to the ground being frozen. Section 10.4.10 of the CSA standards states: Winter weather conditions reduce the effectiveness of surfacing material. These conditions shall be considered by the owner/operator.

A reminder to ensure that all incident logs are signed by the parent.
