Comments: While the infants are waiting by the diaper changing area, the cement stairs next to the bathroom is accessible. The infants were exploring the area and the open access to these stairs poses a safety risk. The Quality Assurance Monitor has offered a few suggestions of measures that can be implemented to ensure the safety of the infants during this period. While waiting for a more permanent solution, the administrator will assist during the diaper changing to provide added supervision to the infants who are waiting to get their diaper changed.

Comments: The fence facing away from the building in the infant outdoor places has spaces between boards that the children can put their arms through the fence. On the other side there is a house. During the monitoring inspection, a dog was on the other side loose in its yard and went to the fence and was growling. An infant was putting her arms through to reach for the dog before the educator intervened. The fence will have to be closed up to prevent the infants from putting their arms through while the dog is in its yard. The administrator will place cardboard temporarily to close the gaps while waiting for a permanent solution.								
General Comments								
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the children during their snack time, during a diaper changing and during their outdoor play time. Positive child guidance was observed during the visit. The educator was using both French and English during transitions to help both her French and English first language speakers understand what was coming up.								
The Quality Assurance Monitor has made a few recommendations to the administrator to mitigate risks.
