Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the ratio was not respected in the early morning. There were already three infants in the classroom with one educator and a fourth infant arrive in the classroom. In the other classroom, there were two educators with eleven children. One of the educators wanted to go in the infant classroom to respect the ratio but that would have left only one educator with eleven children and that didn't respect the ratio in that classroom. The inspector requested to call the administrator or other educators to come at the facility to meet ratio. The administrator came at the facility and went into the infant classroom to meet ratio. By the time an other educator came at the facility, the 2 year old classroom has over ratio. To ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, the child-to-staff ratio must be maintained at all time, that includes, during the operating hours of the facility, during arrival/departure times and during staff lunch/breaks and during outdoor play. The inspector referred the administrator and the operator to section 8 of the Operator Manuel.

During nap time, the educators inform the inspector that they leave the promises when they are on breaks. During lunch breaks when children are napping, staff members included in the child-to-staff ratio must remain on-site and are easily accessible within the building. The inspector referred the administrator and the operator to section 8 of the Operator Manuel.
