31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jul 28, 2023	
Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a hole in a rusty metal frame next to the outdoor play area door. This must be repaired to ensure that children do not injure themselves on the rusty metal. The administrator has contacted their general contractor to make the repairs as soon as possible.			
31(4) An operator shall ensure that the outdoor play area of a licensed facility (a) includes a shaded area that is at least 10% of the outdoor play area.	31(4)(a)	Jul 31, 2023	
Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed no shade in the infant outdoor play area. Some equipment must be added to ensure that the infants have adequate shaded areas to play in.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Jul 26, 2023	
Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a little tyke slide in the infant play area with no protective surfacing. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the administrator if they have verified if the play structure requires a protective surface. The administrator has shared that they do not know but they will verify. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommends that the infants do not use the play structure until this has been verified. The Quality Assurance Monitor has also noticed that there was not sufficient protective surfacing at the bottom of a slide in the preschool outdoor play area. The administrator has racked the rocks back into place and has confirmed that they will notify the operator to add more protective surface.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the early morning ratios. The ratios were respected at all times during the inspection.</p> <p>Snack time and indoor free play was observed during the inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding outdoor play. The administrator has confirmed that the children go outside twice a day for a hour each unless there is heavy rain or the weather is above 33 degrees Celsius.</p>
