Comments: A can of shaving cream is left on a shelf in one of the classrooms. All toxic products are to be locked and out of reach of children.

Comments: Several water bottles in each of the classrooms are not identified. All water bottles are to be identified in order to prevent and control communicable diseases and illness.
