In one file, the medical practitioner's information was missing, In another file, no address nor phone number was provided for the child's medical practitioner. In a third file, the address to the medical practitioner was incomplete. All child record files must include the name, the address and the telephone number of the child's medical practitioner. The operator must ensure that all child record files are complete.</p> | | | |

| <p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor verified 12 child record files. In one file, the city part to the address that was provided for the 2 emergency contacts was missing. All child record files must include the name, the address and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contacts. The operator must ensure that all child record files are complete.</p> | | | |

| <p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor verified 12 child record files. In one file, the consent for bathing and showering in the event of illness or soiled clothing was missing. Wether or not the parent consents to this, it must be inserted in all child record files. The operator must ensure that all consents are included in every child record.</p> | | | |

| <p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a bottle of Oxy Clean in the bathroom. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The educator immediately moved the product to a locked storage space. Deficiency is now compliant</p> | | | |
| <p>40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.</p> | 40(1)(a) | Nov 29, 2024 | |
| <p>Comments: 8 out of 19 water bottles are not labelled with the name of the child. Children's personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child in order to prevent and control communicable diseases and illness. The operator must ensure that all personal belongings are labelled.</p> | | | |
| <p>47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.</p> | 47(1) | Nov 29, 2024 | |
| <p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor verified 12 child record files. In one file, the proof of immunization was missing. Child records must include a proof of immunization or an exemption prior to the child's entry. The operator must ensure that all child record files are complete.</p> | | | |

| General Comments |
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| <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The followings were observed at the time of the visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child to staff ratio - child record files - if children's personal belongings are labelled and stored separately for each child - washrooms - Diaper <p>The ratio is respected at the time of the visit.</p> <p>There are sufficient and safe washroom facilities to meet the needs of the number and ages of children enrolled in the facility.</p> <p>Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained.</p> <p>Changing surface is equipped with rails or safety straps and is covered with a non-absorbent layer. Children are always supervised during diaper change.</p> <p>During the inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor observed snack time and indoor play. The infants are observed painting, and the 3 yrs old children are observed drawing a self-portrait.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the on-site administrator regarding the children's medical practitioner's information in the child record files. The QAM observed that in some of the child record files, the information of a medical clinic was included instead of a medical practitioner. Parents are asked to include the medical practitioner's information. If families do not have a medical practitioner and are on a waiting list for one, they must note that information in the child record files for licensing staff to verify.</p> |
