Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a new play structure had been added to the outdoor play area without enough protective surface underneath. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the administrator that an appropriate protective surface must be installed and that children are not permitted to use the play structure until this requirement is met. The Quality Assurance Monitor also advised the administrator to refer to the manufacturer's manual to determine the appropriate type of protective surfacing required. The administrator must submit a change of service whenever a modification is made to the facility.

Comments: While verifying the outdoor playground, it was observed that there were only 3 balls between both infants and preschool. It was also observed that they were missing items to play in the sand box in the preschool outdoor playground. The administration must ensure that Varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. The administrator mentioned that she throughout some balls and was going to replace them.

Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a new play structure had been added to the outdoor play area without enough protective surface underneath. <p>Comments: Upon arrival, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a child alone in the hallway for approximately two minutes without supervision. The educator indicated that the child goes there when feeling overwhelmed. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded staff that children must be always supervised and instructed the educator to bring the child back into the classroom. While the educator was attempting to bring the child to the room, another child left the classroom to use the washroom and was not followed by an educator. Additionally, one educator was using their phone and did not notice the child entering the classroom. Administrators and educators must ensure active supervision at all times by maintaining awareness of all children's whereabouts and remaining with the group.</p> <p>Deficiency is now compliant</p>			

General Comments
<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site mid-afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection and measure the outdoor playground.</p> <p>The following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child Records and Consent forms - Medication records - Incident reports - Washrooms and diaper procedures - Outdoor play area - Personal Belongings <p>During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children during nap time and the transition to snack time. One classroom had a light table set up for the infants, while another classroom was engaged in a dance party.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one staff member's file was missing a valid First Aid certificate. The administrator indicated that the staff member completed the course on June 3; however, the certificate has not yet been received. Once it is obtained, the administrator must place a copy in the staff file and forward it via email, or the monitor will verify it during the next visit.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed playground maintenance with the administrator, as broken toys were observed on the playground. Educators are required to remove any damaged toys and are encouraged to document and to report it to the administrator.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that they have begun their 10 hours of professional development and that their quality improvement plan has been updated for 2026.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the visit.</p>
