Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. Today during my visit I observed the cabinet unlocked, sanitizing solution bottle was not labelled and not stored out of reach of children. The Operator addressed these infractions immediately. I also suggested storing the key in the kitchen and to advise staff of storage location.			

General Comments

Monitoring visit performed. Kelsey Colford accompanied me on this visit. I advised the operator she will be the Licensing Inspector and to go ahead and change her name on the Bulletin Board. One compliance noted above was addressed during my visit.

This was my first visit to this facility since they opened recently. They are offering school age summer camps between July and end of August. All school age children have opportunities for outdoor play in the AM and PM. They are in walking distance to O'dell and Wilmot Parks. This centre will close for the last week of August to prepare for school age program commencing in September.

I reviewed new staff information, and attendance records which were being documented daily. I also recommended that fire drills be practiced with each weekly group, so children are familiar with the drill routine. The Operator took us for a tour of the facility. It is bright, spacious, and inviting. Educators were observed providing encouragement (I love the drawing, yes you are doing a great job on your portrait etc) and they provide ample transition time between activities (in 5 minutes you will be moving to the Pop Art room to work on your portraits). They were rotating the children from one room to the next. Tomorrow they are having an Art show, so all children were involved in either table top activities, Lego, puzzles, or involved with the sketch book challenge, Pop Art area. All of their Art work will be on display for parents at the Art show.

I discussed my observations with the Operator as I was unable to complete the monitoring report online as licensing staff computer was disabled.
