<p>General Comments</p> <p>The purpose of the visit was for the annual license renewal inspection. Upon arrival the children were participated in some free play activities such as magnetic blocks and toy trucks. The children had snack and prepared for a trip to the park, The children wear vests so they can be easily seen by the operator. The children rode bikes to the park. They all wore helmets. The operator took a wagon full of materials to use while at the park. There were pots, shovels, containers of kinetic sand with colored gems and other materials. Some of the children played with the kinetic sand while others played on the swings and slide. It was a very windy day and the children wanted to play in the trees and found a secret path through the forest. The children were getting cold, so the operator decided to take the children back home. Once everyone was inside and settled, they worked on a "Earth Day" craft the operator had prepared earlier. The operator follows the leads of the children and is engaged in the children's activities. She asks many open-ended questions to create conversation and develop language skills. The children are familiar with the routine and seem comfortable in the environment.</p>
