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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed early learning and child care home for the annual renewal inspection. Upon arrival, only one child was present. The operator was seen greeting the parents and the children as they arrived for the day. The children chose books to read during circle time. The operator was heard asking open ended questions and showing the books to the children. The children were seen trying to find the images in the books in the playroom. The operator and children played in a sensory bin before doing a craft. They were painting ice cream cones with sponges, bingo dabbers, and markers. The operator sat with the children and commented on their work. The children washed their hands after painting and engaged in free play as the operator prepared snack. The children washed their hands and sat down to eat their apples, apple sauce, and crackers. After snack, the children washed their hands and started getting ready to go outside. The operator helped the children get their snowsuits on. The operator brought the first aid kit outside with them.</p> <p>While outside, the children were seen playing in the sandbox, kitchen, and with ride-on cars. Some children were seen going down the slide. The children and operator then returned inside for lunch. The children washed their hands and played with books and magnets as the operator prepared lunch. The children washed their hands and sat down to eat waffles and bananas. The operator supervised the children as they ate. After lunch, the children washed their hands and engaged in free play as the operator cleaned up. The operator did diaper changes and helped the children get settled for nap time. The children fell asleep.</p> <p>The operator is attentive to the children, speaks kindly to them, and was heard praising them. The operator was seen comforting the children when they were upset.</p> <p>The indoor environment was clean and well-organized. Resources are accessible to the children on low, open, and labeled shelves. The children's artwork, pictures, and learning stories with ties to the curriculum were posted on the walls. The outdoor environment was well-maintained and free of hazards.</p> <p>Required documentation and files were checked and found to be complete. Only positive child guidance was observed.</p>
