Comments: A portion of the outdoor play area is currently enclosed with chicken wire, which does not meet the requirements for a secure and appropriately gated fence. This issue was discussed during the previous licensing year, at which time plans for a new fence were mentioned. Licensing staff will return to the facility once the new fence has been installed.			
31(5.1) The outdoor play area of a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre shall include a shaded area of at least 0.45 m ² for each child that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area as provided under subparagraph 4(1)(g)(ii)	31(5.1)	Jul 24, 2026	
Comments: The preschool outdoor play area does not have adequate shade available before noon. Please ensure that sufficient shade is available for children at all times while using the outdoor play area. This concern was discussed prior to inspection and a plan to provide appropriate shade was identified. Licensing staff will return to the facility once the shade structure or other approved shading solution has been installed.			

General Comments

Upon licensing staff arrival for the renewal inspection, the children were engaged in outdoor play. The outdoor space offers a variety of areas for different types of play, including an elevated sandbox, a ground-level sandbox, a bike track, and a garden that the children help care for. Educators were observed supervising and interacting with the children. Several children showed interest in insects, and educators supported this by encouraging exploration and discussion. The infants were playing in their own separate outdoor play area, which included age-appropriate materials such as Little Tikes ride-on toys, sandboxes, and push karts. The infant group transitioned indoors for lunch. Diapering procedures and handwashing were observed and followed. One educator completed diaper changes while another prepared lunches at the table.

The remaining groups followed indoors for lunch shortly after. For the groups that nap, cots were set up appropriately with each child's blanket and belongings. The older preschool group had quiet time instead of rest. Children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including slime, kinetic sand, and the dramatic play area. The educator also set out puzzles for children who chose to use them.

Throughout the visit, programming and documentation of the curriculum were visible across the facility. Positive

child guidance was consistently observed, with educators using encouraging language and supportive interactions. Staff and child files are in compliance.

Licensing staff will recommend the program for renewal once the identified deficiencies are brought into compliance.
