### General Comments

#### Monitoring Inspection - School-Age Full Day Summer Program:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including open ended art, fort building, fine motor activities, and reading stories. Children were not able to go outside this afternoon due to a heat warning in the area however, they spent extra time outdoors this morning before it was too hot.

The indoor learning environment is set-up with a variety of materials on low open shelving that allow children to explore freely. Loose parts and real-life items have been added to the environment for the children to explore.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the indoor area. A variety of documentation is displayed that supports the children's current interests (forts, slime, baking/cooking, board games, chalk) and learning experiences.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.

Discussed that a copy of the Extreme Allergy Plans are to be kept with EpiPens on site.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

New staff file (2) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
