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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including outdoor play, dramatic play, fine motor activities, open-ended art, and sensory opportunities. The infants were observed exploring sensory bottles and reading stories with their educators. The children in the Twos Room had explored painting with a whole watermelon and on a large sheet of paper. The children in the Fours Room were "cooking" in the dramatic play kitchen with a variety of dishes, utensils and pretend food items.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (babies, construction, weather, food, ocean and bugs). The sand table in the Fours Room has materials collected from nature added for the children to explore.</p> <p>A table and chairs have been added to the hallway outside the washroom; where children can engage in an activity or choose from a variety of fidgets accessible to them. This has helped support children during transition times.</p> <p>Nap time was observed today. The environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap. The educators in the Infant Room have displayed each child's nap routine on the wall by their cribs to support nap time when a relief staff is there.</p> <p>Chicken strips, steamed vegetables, and mashed potatoes with a vegetarian gravy were served for lunch. Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play, during washroom routines, and before mealtimes. Monthly fire drills are documented.</p> <p>Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.</p> <p>Infant Daily Information sheets observed to be completed throughout the day.</p>

New staff file (4) review was completed. One staff requires a job description and to be registered for the NB Curriculum Framework course.

Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (8/8) requirement.
